



2018 Wisconsin Art Education Association Youth Art Month Artwork Submission Guidelines

Artwork Requirements

- Final size of the work, including mat, may not be larger than 22" X 26" X 2".
- All work, except canvas board or stretched canvases, must be matted or top mounted on sturdy mat, tag board or foam core. The mat should complement not overpower the artwork. The edge of the stretched canvas should be finished or painted.
- Canvas board or stretched canvas must be ready to hang for display with a picture framing wire or hanging device. Art work will be hung with T-Pins at the regional and state shows. If you can't make it work, neither can the YAM committee!
- Labels must be attached to the front of the artwork. If labels extend beyond the edge of the artwork, they should be mounted on tag board or they get damaged or torn off during transport.
- No art work in frames with or without glass.
- Any work made with smearable media (pastel, oil pastel, charcoal, ebony pencil, etc.) must be covered with plastic or Mylar. This is to protect not only the artwork but the other artwork it comes in contact with. Other artwork may also be wrapped in plastic to keep it clean. It is the teachers' responsibility to take the necessary precautions to protect the artwork.
- No group pieces. All artwork must be created by one individual student within the last year. Only one artwork per student may be submitted.
- Artwork that does not follow these guidelines will not be accepted.

A completed YAM registration includes the following:

Online registration

- When online registration has been completed, you will receive an e-mail with the permission form and labels to include with your artwork. Information not available when completing online registration (like parent permission for awards) can be skipped and added to forms after they are printed before submitting them with the artwork.

Student artwork delivered or sent to regional vp:

- 5 student artworks (or less) with label attached to front right corner and permission slip attached to back of each artwork
- Inventory sheet (simply a copy of the labels before they are cut apart)
- Permission slip for each student loose with the inventory sheet
- \$15 check payable to Wisconsin Art Education Association
