



Art Communication board for receptive or initiative language with non verbal clients, students, residents, participants, etc. You can place in front of your person so they can determine choices-asking them to indicate with gesture or touching as needed. Or you can use it to ask them about choices in the moment. This is an example and may not meet your needs for materials or choices. Can use real photos of materials or this kind of image that may be used in schools, BoardMaker-a speech/language pathologist may be able to help you make one, or you can customize one yourself. Make copies and have available on the workspaces for communication support. If possible, laminate or put between 2 pieces of contact paper to protect the surface for those with moisture control issues.
